madcap	— Madcap means very silly.	5
madman	— A madman is a crazy person.	5
madmen	— Madmen are two or more crazy people.	7
magnet	— A magnet is a piece of metal, like iron or steel, that sticks to other metals.	7
mascot	— A mascot is a symbol for a team, often an animal.	5
mash	— To mash something is to make it soft, like mashed potatoes.	6
mat	— A small rug, such as a rug in a bathroom.	1
max	— Max is a short word for 'maximum' and means the most.	10
mesh	— 1. Mesh is a net-like cloth you can see through. 2. To mesh is to work well together.	7
mid	— Mid means in the middle.	4
midship	— Midship is the middle part of a ship.	10
mill	— A mill is a place where grain is ground to make flour.	10
mimic	— To mimic something means to act like that thing, such as mimicking a dog by crawling and barking.	5
misfit	— A misfit is someone who isn't like the other people around him.	5
mishmash	— A mishmash is a mix of things.	6
mob	— A mob is a group of angry people.	9
moth	— A moth is bug that looks like a plain brown butterfly.	6
muck	— Muck is mud.	7
muff	— A muff is a tube-like covering to keep hands warm. Ear muffs cover the ears to keep them warm.	8
muffin	— A muffin is a small round breakfast cake or bread that is sweet.	5
mug	— A mug is a heavy cup with a handle.	4
mum	— To be mum is to keep quiet and not tell a secret.	4
mush	— Mush is a squishy mess.	6
